

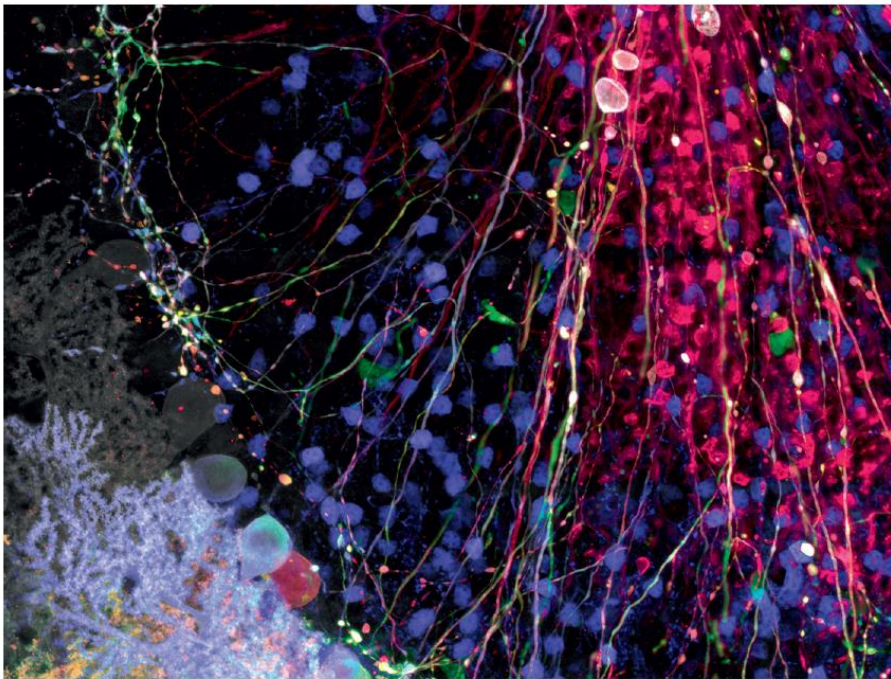
Good Imaging Practice

Lunch and Learn Session on January 14th 2021, 11:30

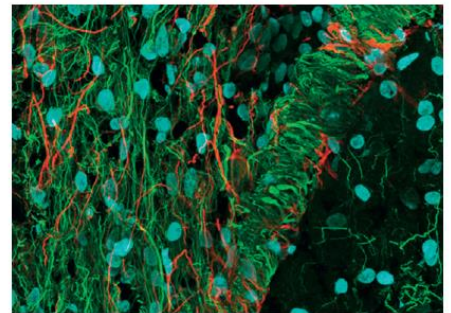

This lunch and learn seminar will cover several relevant topics like signal-to-noise, contrast and resolution and provide some hints on how to prepare your images to present your data.

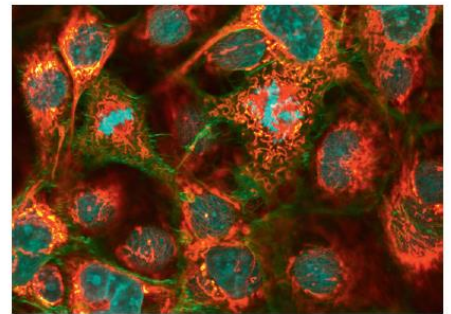
This session will be supplemented with a short introduction to the Olympus FV3000 confocal microscope.
