Kurzbeschreibung:

Classrooms are becoming increasingly heterogeneous. Hence, it is crucial to reflect on aspects of diversity (such as disability, ethnicity, and language) and how they influence what is going on in the classroom to facilitate educational success and social participation for students of all backgrounds.

As part of the seminar, students will participate in a live online-workshop co-hosted by the University of Oldenburg, the University of Groningen and Nelson Mandela University (South Africa) on Thursday, November 5th and Friday, November 6th. In this workshop, scholars from all three universities will give short presentations on policies, strategies, and current challenges regarding inclusion and multilingualism in the different countries. There will be plenty of room for discussion and international exchange, as students from the Netherlands and South Africa will also attend this workshop.

Please note: This seminar will be mainly held in English. However, we will allow plenty of opportunities for clarifying questions and translations, if necessary. Depending on the groups' wishes, additional reflections/ discussions on Friday, December 4th could also be held in German.
