

Semester Abroad for Students of English: Non-Binding Learning Agreement

Revised October 2024

It is strongly recommended that **independent and free mover applicants** to European universities (including the UK, Ireland and Malta) as well as those studying on exchange at **partner universities** in the US and Canada, Australia/New Zealand, India, South Africa and elsewhere complete this learning agreement in advance – it makes the credit transfer process when you get back much more efficient and will ensure that you are able to get the maximum amount of credit. This form can also be used by **Erasmus+ students** to get approval for individual modules before submitting an official learning agreement.

¹ A normal full-time course load is **30 ECTS**; we usually require you to successfully complete at least **20 ECTS taught in English** to get credit for the stay abroad itself. This is separate from getting credit for individual courses, for which there is **no** minimum or maximum requirement. A *non-binding learning agreement* is only required if you want to get credit points back in Oldenburg.
