

**Semester Abroad for Students of English: Non-Binding Learning Agreement**

It is strongly recommended that **independent applicants to the UK, Ireland and Malta** and those studying at partner universities in **the US and Canada, Australia/New Zealand, India, South Africa and elsewhere** also complete a learning agreement in advance – it makes the credit transfer process when you get back much more efficient! (This form can also be used by Erasmus students to get approval for individual modules *before* submitting an official learning agreement and has been expanded as of late 2020 to cover **all forms of online study** completed as an **alternative** to going abroad.)
