Mihaela Vosganian:

"Ich glaube es gibt keine Grenze zwischen meinem Schaffen und meinem spirituellen Ansatz; aus diesem Grund habe ich im vergangenen Jahrzehnt eine neue spirituelle Ästhetik gegründet, an die ich wahrhaftig glaube und die ich als "archetypischen Trans-Realismus" bezeichne.

Zum einen ermöglicht diese Gesinnung eine Wiederbelebung der archetypischen Funktionen von Musik wie z. B. die Katharsis, die Heilung und die Ekstase; zum anderen ermöglicht sie es eine andere Form des Surrealen zum Ausdruck zu bringen: das Trans-Reale, das aus erweiterten Zuständen des Bewusstseins hervorgeht, die wiederum aus spirituellen Träumen herrühren. Diese Ästhetik steht ebenfalls in Beziehung zu meinem theoretischen und praktischen Ansatz eines dreifachen Moduls der Vibrations-Therapie, mit dem ich arbeite und in deren Rahmen ich sowohl als Lehrerin, als auch als spirituelle Führerin und Heilerin in Erscheinung trete."

Armine Vosganian

is a Romanian- Armenian actress and film director. She has graduated from both Theatre Acting and Film Directing in 2014 at National University of Theatrical Arts and Cinematography in Bucharest, Romania and a MA Film Making degree at London Film School, UK. She has directed seven short films so far, some of them being in festivals circuit.



Armine has been working closely with her parents, adapting her father's prose and performing concerts with her mother. The family had worked together on operas which were performed at the National Opera of Bucharest. In the present, Mihaela and Armine Vosganian are the founders of the musical movement of Archetipal Transrealism, launching an album of sound therapy entitled "Into my GongSelf".

In 2014, Armine becomes a co-founder of a theatre company, along with her classmates, called *RAMPA* where she's been working as an actress, playwriter and producer. *Rampa* has produced shows such as "The Name" by Jon Fosse, "Lower Depths" by Maxim Gorki, "Staipelochian", based on The Book of Whispers by Varujan Vosganian, "Julie" by August Strindberg and "The Flower Show" by Istvan Orkeny.

Sine 2015, Marina Hanganu, a Central School of Speech and Drama graduate, and Armine have produced one of the first telematic one woman shows in Romania and other educational projects within Tele Encounters company. They also worked on musicals such as "The Suicide Shop" based on Jean Teule's novel.

At the moment, Armine works as director and editor on a docu-series exploring Armenian Diasporas and began her PhD programme at the National University of Theatrical Arts and Cinematography in Bucharest.
