DAAD contact grants for International Doctoral Candidates

The Carl von Ossietzky University of Oldenburg in Germany aims to strengthen its international ties and to increase the number of international doctoral candidates at the Carl von Ossietzky University of Oldenburg. In line with this, scholarships financed by the Scholarship and Supervision Program for International Doctoral Candidates of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) will be awarded for stays of international doctoral candidates between 2016 and 2018 by the Graduate Academy and the International Student Office. The supported doctoral candidates must be registered doctoral students at one of the partner universities of the University of Oldenburg and need to be integrated into a research group. The duration of the stay should be between one and six months.

International doctoral candidates may apply for these scholarships with the following documents:

- Application form (see <u>http://www.uni-oldenburg.de/en/iso/</u>)
- A CV
- a supportive statement of the supervisor at the home university
- a letter of the research group at the University of Oldenburg outlining the (planned) involvement of the international doctoral candidate in the group

<u>The application deadline for research stays in 2016 is June 1st, 2016.</u> The application deadlines for 2017 and 2018 will be announced in due course. The intended stay may, at the earliest, commence one month after the application deadline, the monthly scholarship for the stay amounts to 950 EUR.
