

To get from Bremen Airport to Oldenburg Train Station (Hauptbahnhof)

Bremen is a small airport and in general it does not take long to go through passport control, collect your luggage and pass through customs.

Bus

Depending on your time of arrival, you can take a bus called PublicExpress www.publicexpress.net. Check this website for the times of the buses on the day you arrive. This website is available in English so you can also easily plan your return to Bremen Airport from Oldenburg's train station.

This bus takes you directly to Oldenburg's train station and you don't need to change or stand around in the cold.

You can buy a ticket on the bus. A one-way ticket to Oldenburg train station costs 8 euros, when purchased in the bus.

Train

The other alternative to get from the airport is to take a tram to Bremen train station and then the train to Oldenburg. Bremen Airport is only 3.5 km away from the main railway station and the city center. You can get from the airport to the main railway station in only 16 minutes using **tram no. 6** (at peak times they run at five-minute intervals) and you get off right in front of the terminal. To get from the tram stop to your platform you should add about 5-7 minutes.

The trains generally leave at quarter past the hour and 5/6 minutes to the hour and leave from platforms 2 or 3; please check <http://www.deutschebahn.com/site/bahn/en/start.html> for actual information. You should purchase your ticket in the ticket hall or from a machine (there are many of these spread around the station as well as on the platform) before getting on the train. It is not generally necessary to book in advance for this short stretch. The journey to Oldenburg takes approximately 30 minutes.

In Oldenburg

Once at Oldenburg Hauptbahnhof (Central Station) if you leave the station at the north exit you will come out at the ZOB (Central Omnibus Station), where most buses leave and there is a taxi rank. If you exit at the south there is also the possibility of getting a taxi and there are also a few bus stops.

The University of Oldenburg has two main sites:

Campus Haarentor (Ammerländer Heerstraße/Uhlhornsweg) is serviced by bus numbers 306-Universität, 310-Wehnen/Famila-Center and 324-Infanterieweg. The name of the stop is „Universität“.

and

Campus Wechloy (Carl von Ossietzky-Straße 9-11) is only serviced by bus number 306/306E. The stop is called “Carl-von-Ossietzky Strasse” and it is the end of the line.

Campus Wechloy is where PPRE and the Energy Laboratory, amongst others, are located; W02 1-181 for Julia Rudman's office.

Walking distance between the two campuses: ten minutes.
