

Guidelines

for preparing a thesis (text section)

Please note the following when writing your thesis:

- Use the A4 format
- Design the title page according to the **sample on page 3 of these guidelines**
- The topic of the thesis must be stated on the title page as specified
- Line spacing must be 1½ lines for text pages; margins on the left and right must be 3 - 4 cm and 2 - 3 cm at the top and bottom
- Font and font size e.g. Arial 11 or Times New Roman 12 (or comparable fonts / font sizes)
- All sources and aids must be specified using the standard format
- All passages taken verbatim or in spirit from other publications must be labelled accordingly
- Put the table of contents (and illustrations) at the beginning
- The [regulations on the principles for ensuring good academic practice at the University of Oldenburg](#) must be observed.
- Depending on the requirements in the examination regulations that apply to you, you must enclose a signed declaration of originality or an affidavit in accordance with the regulations on good scientific practice with your thesis. This must be included in the PDF and signed.
- The wording of this declaration is:

Special aspects of group work:

Before you insert the declaration of independence or affidavit mentioned on page 1, you must first provide a list of "the contributions of the individual candidates to be assessed as examination performance" based on the specification of sections, page numbers or other objective criteria, so that a clear delimitation and individual assessment of the individual performances is possible.

The declaration of independence or affidavit must be signed by each author of the group work.

Please also note that approved extensions of writing time due to illness or due to compensation for disadvantages do not always apply to all persons to be examined in the group work! Please inform yourself in good time.

If the data is too large for an email, you may send us your thesis via the UniCloud.

Please discuss with your supervisor whether your school or subject has any special requirements for the preparation of your thesis.

You must submit your thesis to the Examinations Office to meet the deadline. Submitting your thesis late without good reason will result in a failing grade - so please be sure to observe the deadlines!

You can send a printed version of your thesis directly to your supervisors at their request.

If you would like to claim allowances for special needs when working on your thesis, please apply for this before the start of the editing period if possible, so that you can plan better during the writing process.

Allowances for special needs can be claimed due to [chronic illness or disability](#) or due to [caring responsibilities](#).

Repeating the final thesis

The thesis may be repeated once if it has been assessed as "failed" or is deemed to have been "failed". A second repetition is excluded. The repetition is only permitted in the subject in which the first attempt was made. A change of subject is excluded.
