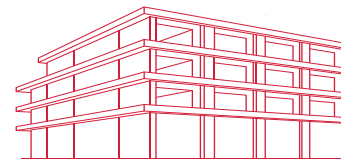

OUR CAMPUSES

We're spread across three main campuses - Stoke on-Trent, Stafford and London. No matter where you're based, you'll get a warm welcome and access to University services.

WHERE WE ARE

Our Stoke-on-Trent and Stafford campuses are ideally connected by road and rail as both are close to the M6 and mainline train stations.

Stoke-on-Trent is known locally as the Potteries due to its heritage as the world capital of ceramics. It's a friendly city made up of six distinctive towns. Our main campus is within walking distance of Hanley, the city centre. It's also a 35-minute drive away from Alton Towers. Stoke-on-Trent is rated one of the 10 most affordable cities in the UK for student accommodation (StudentCrowd).

Our Stafford campus is on the edge of the county town, with a regular shuttle bus to the town centre and Stafford station. The area is also steeped in culture and history, with Stafford Castle and the Shugborough Estate among the attractions.

Our London campus is based at the creative and technological hub Here East. It's set within Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park in Stratford, east London - the former home of the 2012 Olympics.

We also have a higher education centre in Lichfield, where you can study media production and education courses in partnership with South Staffordshire College.

IMMERSE YOURSELF IN HEALTHCARE EDUCATION

Our £5.8m Centre for Health Innovation has transformed the way we deliver courses to healthcare students.

Features include one of the world's largest 'simmersive' suites – a training area where incredibly realistic backdrops are projected onto a floor-to-ceiling space.

You can be placed at the scene of a road accident, with passing cars, street lights and noise or extricate a casualty from a vehicle parked inside the room.

The facilities enable you to learn in a safe environment, where you can practise clinical skills and experience the feel of real-world working.



CLINICAL SIMULATION SUITES

Treat high-quality realistic manikin patients. Our simulation-based settings include a hospital ward, operating theatre and emergency department.



IMMERSIVE SUITES

Use impressive augmented and virtual reality technologies to practise your skills in different training environments.



LIFE-LIKE LIVING SPACE

Step inside and feel like you're visiting a real house. Can be used to help treat mock patients.



BIRTHING SIMULATION

Our midwifery skills facilities are equipped with a state-of-the-art birthing woman and newborn manikins.



PARAMEDIC TRAINING AMBULANCE

Put your learning into action with this fully equipped training vehicle. It's also used as part of the External Simmersion Area.



LARGE-SCALE SIMULATION SPACE

This space immerses users in a variety of environments and incidents, simulating sights and sounds - it's even big enough to drive an ambulance in.



EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT SIMULATIONS

Our simmersion rooms enable students from different disciplines to work together in different scenarios, such as resuscitation.



OPERATING THEATRE SIMULATION

Our fully equipped Operating Department Practitioner Simmersion space prepares students from operating theatre and anaesthetics to surgery and recovery.

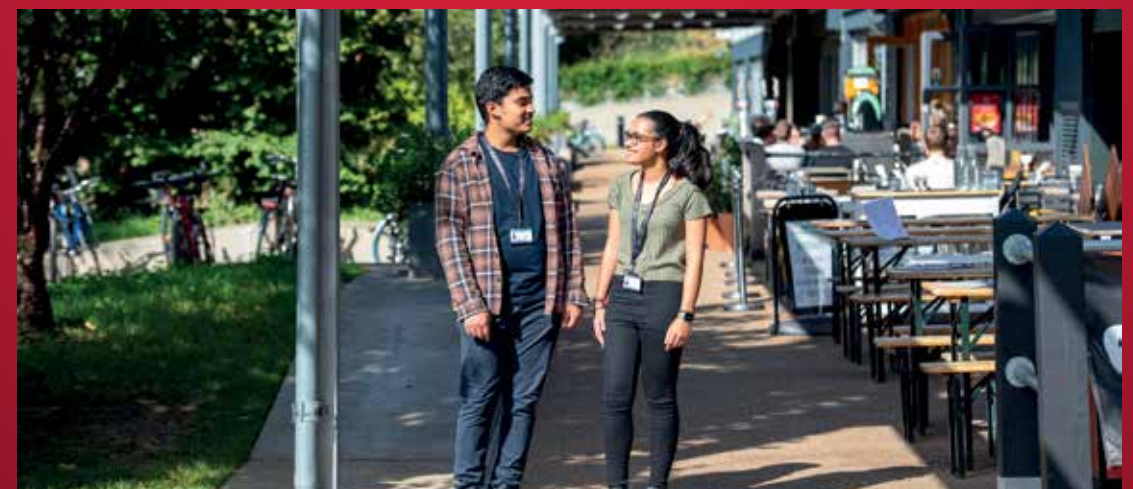
PRODUCTION WAREHOUSE

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Do you need assistance with academic writing, critical thinking or exam preparation? Our Academic Skills Team, based in the library, is here to help. Students can arrange one-to-one appointments with the team or access detailed support online.

INCLUSION TEAM

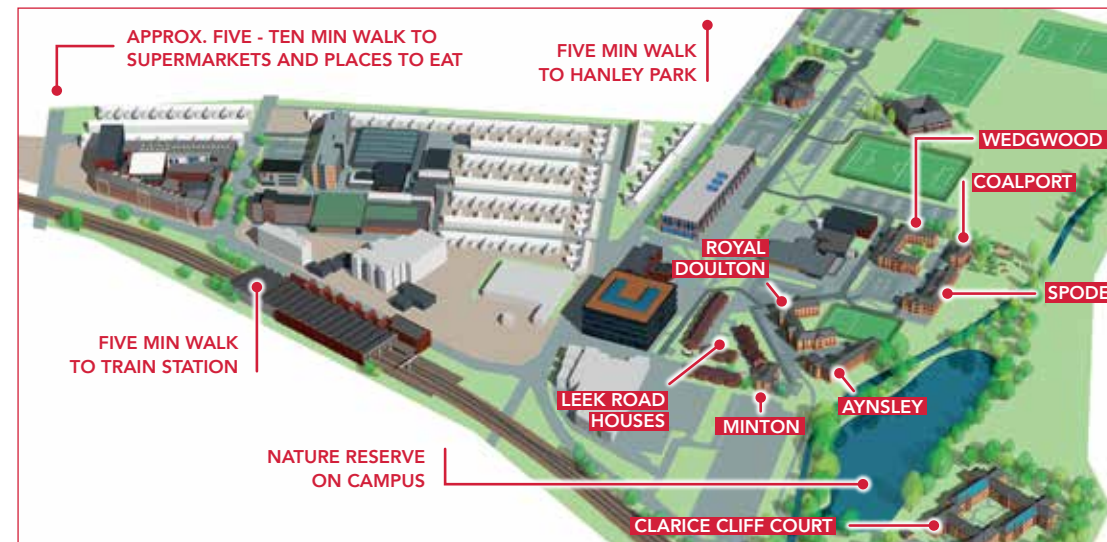
ON-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Most of our courses require a minimum IELTS score of 6.0 overall with 5.5 in each component or an equivalent approved qualification. However, some courses have higher entry requirements – please see the individual course pages for more information.

EXEMPTIONS

You won't need to provide evidence of English language skills if you come from: or hold a degree from a majority English speaking country, you're a UK national or have completed a degree at another UK University.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE SUPPORT

Pre-sessional English Language* courses are available if you do not meet the English language requirements. Visit staffs.ac.uk/language-support

We also offer in-session courses for on-going support whilst you are studying.

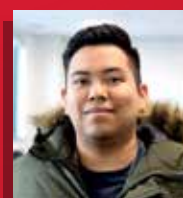
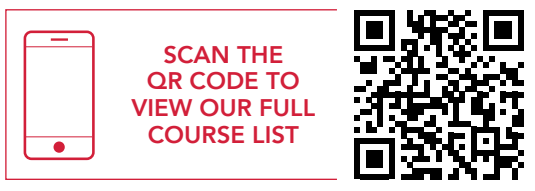
