Immigration procedures	Before arrival: Citizens of states not belonging to the European Union, the European Economic Area or		
	Switzerland must apply for a student visa.		
	<b>Upon arrival:</b> Citizens of states not belonging to the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland, if their stay is of over 6 months, they must apply for a Foreigner Identity Card.		
	More information about these procedures can be found at our <u>Welcome Guide</u> .		
Insurance	For their temporary stay in Spain, students from the EU must get the <b>European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)</b> before leaving their countries.		
	<ul> <li>All exchange students/professors/staff visiting Universidad de Valladolid in the framework of any international mobility programme or bilateral agreement are required to have an insurance policy covering the following eventualities:</li> <li>Accident</li> <li>Illness (international medical evacuation inclusive)</li> <li>Repatriation in case of death</li> <li>Health insurance (if not eligible for a EHIC) The students/staff will present the insurance policy upon their arrival. The mentioned policy (or its corresponding official translation) is accepted in any of the following languages:</li> <li>Spanish (preferably), English, French, Italian and Portuguese.</li> </ul>		
	In case they do not have an insurance policy that covers the mentioned eventualities, Universidad de Valladolid offers the possibility of contracting a policy covering their complete period of mobility, regardless of its duration.		
Mentor Programme	UVa offers one-to-one support to incoming students before and during their stay.		
	To participate in the programme, students must select this option in their application process.
