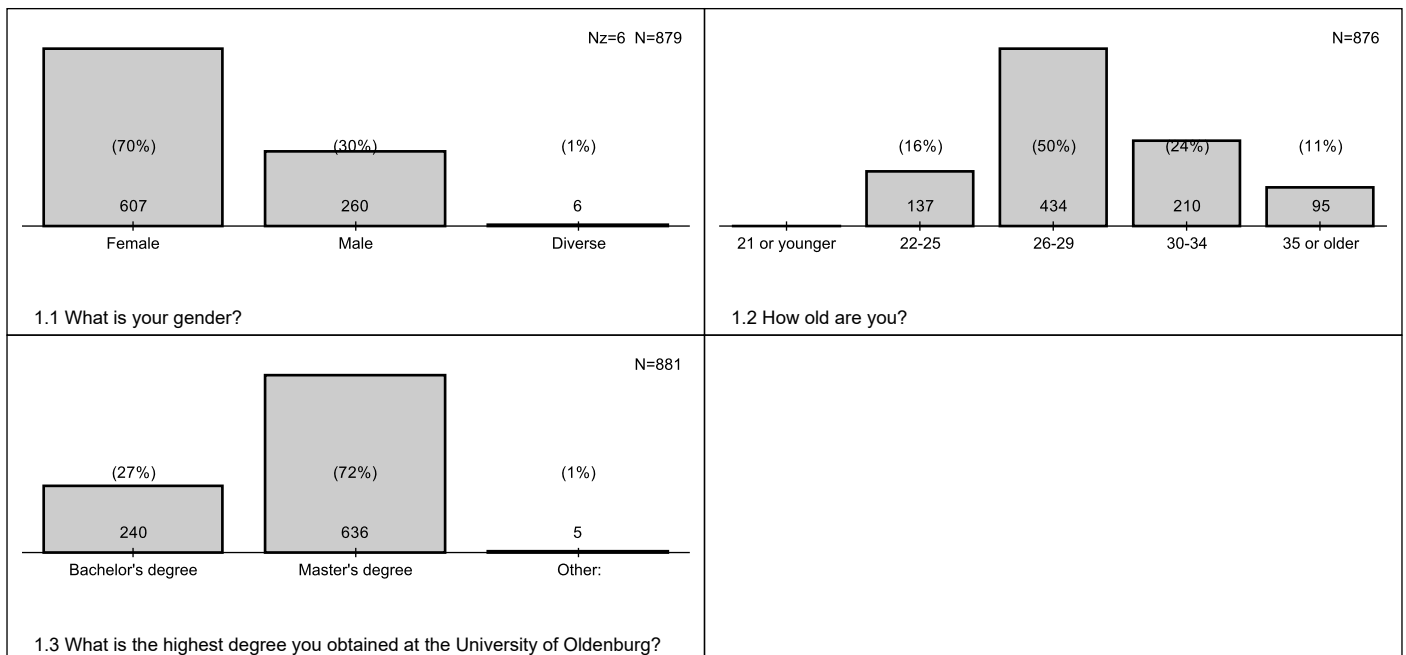
Explanation of the visualization

4. The mean value and the standard deviation are shown in the lower part of the image. The median response is highlighted in gray.

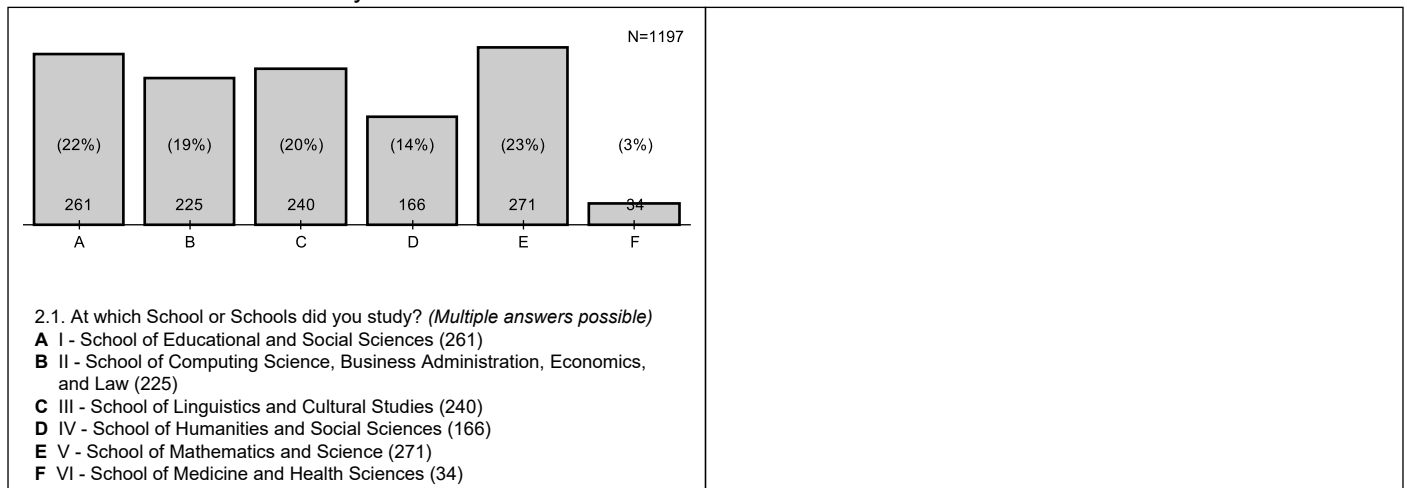
