

## Funding for Ideas around Research-Based Learning

The Research-Based Learning Grant Program aims at assisting instructors and students at the University of Oldenburg in implementing research-based learning. Research-based learning refers to the following practice: Students design, perform and reflect on the research process and its fundamental phases (e.g., finding a research question, collecting and analyzing data, presenting results) and do so apart from their final theses. This funding opportunity is an extension of previous funding of instructional projects, including, for example, research projects on research-based learning or subject/faculty specific measures on research-based learning.

### ➤ Who is eligible for funding?

All instructors and staff members at the University of Oldenburg may apply to this funding opportunity. Student participation is welcome.

### ➤ What is being funded?

Instructors and staff can apply for funds totaling up to €3,000 per semester for hiring student assistants and/or for material resources.

The decision will be made by a committee consisting of representatives from all schools and acting on behalf the Vice President for Studies and Teaching.

### ➤ How to apply?

- The submission deadline for funding in the summer semester is 10. January.
- The submission deadline for funding in the winter semester is 10. June.

- Short description of approaches and methods for implementing research-based learning (max. 4,500 characters including spaces) and expected number of students. A maximum of one illustration may be attached at this DOCX file. References can be added separately to this DOCX file if required.
