

Funding for Research-Based Learning Instructional Projects

The Research-Based Learning Grant Program aims to assist instructors at the University of Oldenburg in implementing research-based learning methods in their courses. Research-based learning refers to the following practice: Students design, perform and reflect on the research process and its fundamental phases (e.g., finding a research question, collecting and analyzing data, presenting results) and do so apart from their final theses. ➤ Who is eligible for funding?

All instructors at the University of Oldenburg who wish to implement research-based learning methods as part of their courses may apply to this funding opportunity.

➤ What is being funded?

Instructors can apply for funds totaling up to €3,000 per semester for hiring student assistants and/or for material resources.* The decision will be made by a committee consisting of representatives from all schools and acting on behalf the Vice President for Studies and Teaching.

➤ How to apply?

- The submission deadline for funding in the summer semester is 10. January.
- The submission deadline for funding in the winter semester is 10. June.

* Funding for a subsequent course in the following semester is possible (maximum funding €1,500). Please submit a new application at the appropriate time.

Applications must include the following:

- The completed [application form \(DOCX\)](#).
- Short description of approaches and methods for implementing research-based learning (max. 4,500 characters including spaces) and expected number of students. A maximum of one illustration may be attached at this DOCX file. References can be added separately to this DOCX file if required.
