

Conditions of participation in the public vote for the 2024 photo competition:
„Capture your research with a click – Student research in action“

1. Competition organiser and duration

The public vote and voucher raffle for the photo competition is organised by the University of Oldenburg

The public vote for the photo competition ‘Capture your research with a click - Student research in action’ begins on 30 October 2024. The closing date for entries is 10 November 2024, 23:59. Votes submitted after the closing date cannot be considered.

2. Eligibility

All students of the University of Oldenburg who are of legal age are eligible to participate. By participating, students agree to the conditions of participation.

3. How to take part in the public vote of the photo competition

You can take part in the public vote for the photo competition until 10 November 2024, 23:59 via the Stud.IP community forum Photo competition ‘Capture your research with a click – Student research in action’. Before participating in the public vote, the conditions of participation must be agreed to. After agreeing to the conditions of participation, one photo can be selected from all the photo entries.

Once a photo has been voted for, the vote can no longer be changed.

After voting, you can leave the Stud.IP community forum. The votes cast will be saved anonymously.

4. How to participate in the voucher raffle

All participants in the vote can take part in a voucher prize raffle. To take part in the voucher raffle, you must provide a valid email address as well as your first name and surname. This is required for the prize draw and to contact the winners. Five vouchers will be drawn from all participants in the voucher prize draw who have provided the above information.

Raffle prize: Five of the participants in the voucher raffle will be drawn and each will receive a prize. To take part in the voucher prize draw, you must also enter your email address and first and last name in the Stud.IP questionnaire for the public vote.

The winners will be drawn as part of the award ceremony for the photo competition and the awarding of the ‘Award for Excellence in Teaching’ in the BIS hall on 20 November 2024.

The vouchers will be presented immediately afterwards in the BIS Hall.

Winners who are not present will be informed by the University of Oldenburg by e-mail in order to clarify the details of the voucher handout. If the winners have not responded to the notification by 31 December 2024, they will irrevocably forfeit their claim to the voucher.

Participants will not be notified of the outcome of the voucher raffle.

5. Voucher prize

Five vouchers worth €15 each for the 'Stube' café (Ammerländer Heerstraße 108, 26129 Oldenburg) will be raffled off.

6. Other prerequisites

Participation in the photo competition is free of charge.

One photo may be selected per participant.

In order to participate in the vote, a temporary registration in the Stud.IP Community Forum is required. The personal data (first name, last name, email address, degree programme) are visible to the organiser of the vote, but not the vote cast. Participation in the voucher prize draw is only possible by entering your first name, surname and email address.

7. Data protection

By accepting these Conditions for Participation, participants consent to the processing of their personal details (last name, first name, email address, degree programme) being processed for the purpose of carrying out the photo competition.

The first name, last name and degree programme of the winners will be published as part of the publication of the voting results on the university website and/or at a public award ceremony. The University of Oldenburg processes the personal data exclusively for the purpose of organising the competition. The data will not be passed on to third parties and will be deleted or destroyed at the end of the competition.

As a data subject within the meaning of the GDPR, you have the following rights: right of access by the data subject (Art. 15 GDPR); right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR); right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR); right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR); right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR); right to object (Art. 21 GDPR).

8. Exclusion from participation in the vote

If a person violates the Conditions of Participation, the University of Oldenburg as the organiser of the competition shall be entitled to exclude that person from the participation in the vote, particularly if the participant does not have student status.

9. Exclusion from participation in the voucher raffle

If a person violates the Conditions of Participation, the University of Oldenburg as the organiser of the competition shall be entitled to exclude that person from the participation in the voucher raffle, particularly if the participant provides incorrect information.

10. Notice of liability

The University of Oldenburg retains the right to change the Conditions of Participation at any time or to discontinue or end the photo competition at any time without prior notice and without stating any reasons. The university accepts no liability if a person loses a chance to win a prize due to technical problems when submitting the photographs for the competition using the online form.

11. Legal recourse

Legal recourse is excluded.
