What is the Deutschlandstipendium?

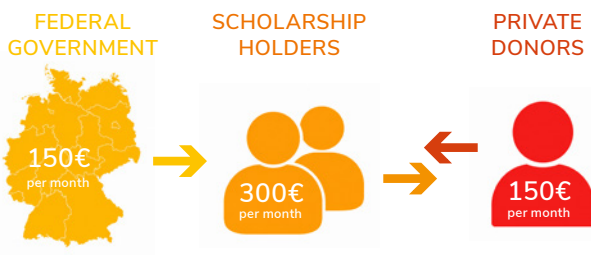
The Deutschlandstipendium is a **nationwide funding programme** which is unique in Germany. It is aimed at particularly committed and high-achieving students from all disciplines at state and state-recognised universities.

Scholarship holders receive a monthly grant of 300 euros, initially for a period of at least two semesters. Funding may be extended annually within the standard period of study and, in justified exceptional cases, beyond that period – provided that academic performance is satisfactory and sufficient funding is available.

How does the programme work?

The Deutschlandstipendium supports talented students. Half of the funding comes from the federal government and the other half from private donors, such as companies, foundations, private individuals or alumni. This not only provides financial support, but also fosters a network between higher education institutions, the business sector and society. This unique partnership between government funding and community involvement makes the programme particularly valuable. Support is provided not only to students with excellent grades, but also to those who get involved, take on responsibility and successfully overcome personal challenges.



How it works – applying in 3 steps

1. **Complete the online application form**
Duration: approx. 20 minutes!
2. **Upload your application documents**
Show what makes you special – commitment counts too!
3. **Send it off and wait**
Acceptance letters will be sent out in October.

Who can apply?

- All enrolled students – regardless of age, nationality or subject.
- First-year students can apply immediately after enrolment. The grades of the university entrance qualification (Allgemeine Hochschulreife, Fach-Abitur, or equivalent qualifications) will be taken into account in the assessment.
- Students who demonstrate excellent academic performance.
- Students who are actively involved in social, political or cultural causes.
- Students who are coping with personal or family challenges, such as caring for relatives, bringing up their own children, living with a chronic illness, or pursuing their education under difficult circumstances.

Applications can be submitted from **1 to 30 September**.
