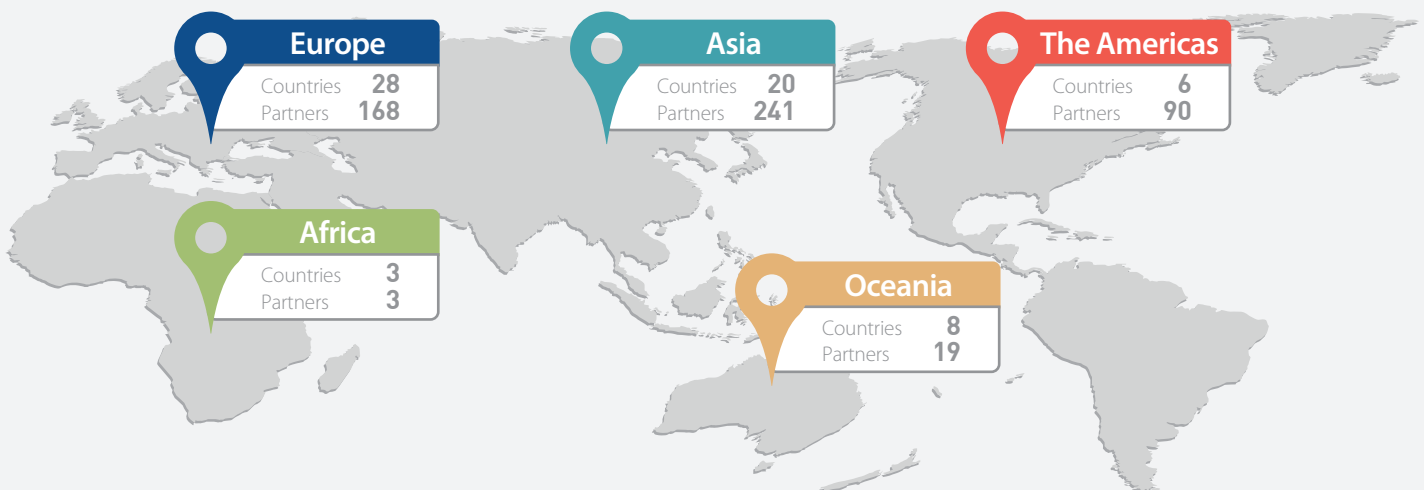

Required documents

1. Certificate of Nationality (applicant & parents), Certificate of Family relationship or Birth Certificate
2. Transcripts of completed degree
3. Certificate of (scheduled) graduation or Diploma
4. Certificate of language proficiency
5. Certificate of Financial support (USD **18,000** deposit)

*All documents should be original copies, If documents are not written in Korean or English, they should be translated into either language and notarized.

*Application Fee: USD **70** or **60,000** KRW

The **Exchange Student Program** is designed for students from partner universities who want to undertake coursework for from one to two semesters at PNU. To be eligible for the exchange program, students need to be nominated by the international office at their home universities.

The **Visiting Student Program** is designed for students from universities that do not have a formal exchange agreement with PNU or that have the agreement but with a limited number of exchange openings. Visiting students can undertake coursework for one or two semesters at PNU but need to check with their home universities regarding credit transfer. Visiting students should pay all educational expenses.

BENEFITS for Exchange & Visiting Students at PNU

- **Free Korean language courses**
Exchange and Visiting students can take free Korean language courses according to their level of proficiency.
- **On-campus housing (university dormitory residence) is available**
- **Buddy Program**
Buddy activities include airport pick-up, guidance in campus life and academic management, and other forms of personal assistance.

Only for exchange students

- Tuition and registration fee waiver
- Government scholarships of around US\$2,500 (for a select number of students only)
- PNU exchange scholarship ranging from US\$430 ~ US\$860 (for a select number of students only)

HOW to APPLY

* **Language Requirements:** *Fluent in Korean or English (no certificate required)*

In order to apply, **exchange students** first need to be nominated by the international office at their home universities. Once nominated, students will receive an email with information on how to complete their online application. **Visiting students** should contact at global@pusan.ac.kr to create account to fill out the application form. 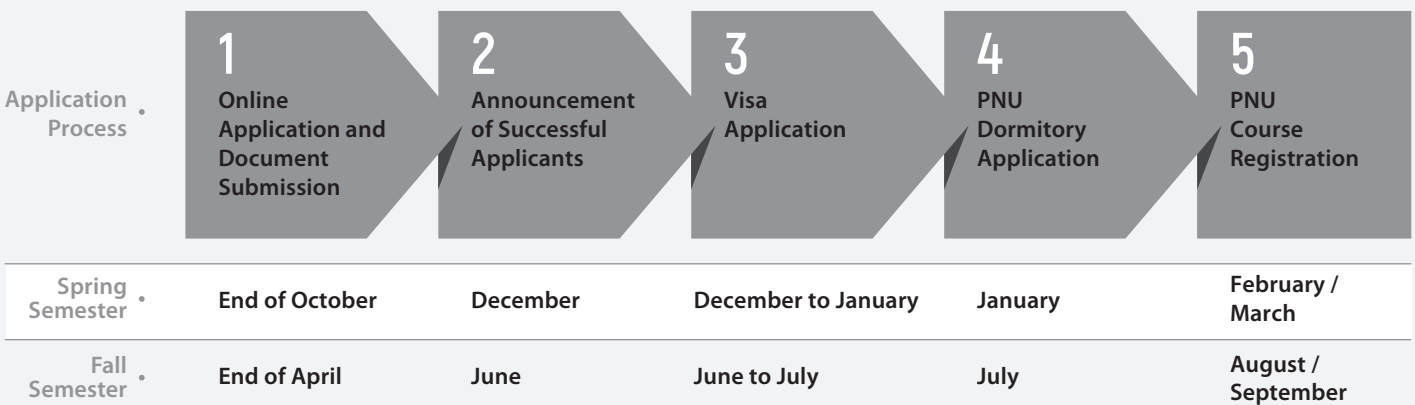

PNU SUMMER SCHOOL

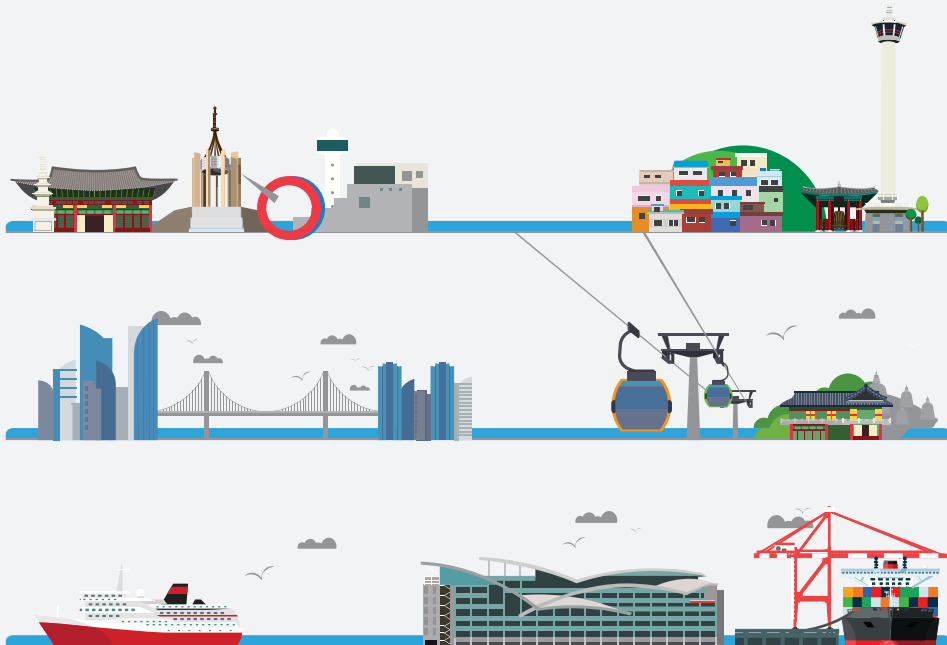

WHY KOREA?

Korea is a mountainous, peninsular country with nearly 5,000 years of history, and one of the most important international transportation hubs of Asia. Nicknamed the “Land of the Morning Calm,” Korea is located at a major crossroads of Northeast Asia. It is one of the largest, most technologically-advanced economies in the world as a result of the “Miracle of the Han River” post-Korean War era of rapid economic development. Since the 1960s, when the country’s five-year economic development plans were first implemented, the Korean economy has relentlessly and exponentially grown. From 1962 to 2018, the country’s GDP surged from US\$2.8 billion to a staggering US\$1.33trillion. Years of rapid economic development have propelled the country into becoming the world’s 12th-largest economy.





With a population of 3.6 million, Busan is the second-largest city in Korea and a center of marine logistics in Northeast Asia. The city hosts one of the world's five "SUPER HUB PORTS" and serves as a gateway to the Eurasian continent.

Busan (also known as 'Pusan') is famous for its natural environment of mountains, rivers and sea, with superb oceanfront vistas such as Haeundae and Gwangali Beaches, scenic cliffs, and some of Asia's most famous hot springs! The city is also a tourism hub featuring such outstanding must-see attractions as the Busan Cinema Center - home of the annual Busan International Film Festival, or BIFF, the largest film festival in Asia - the Busan Aquarium, Nurimaru APEC House, Beomeo Temple, Jagalchi (Seafood) Market, Gamcheon Culture Village, the world's largest department store, Shinsegae in Centum City, and many others. Busan is a city of natural beauty, vibrancy, tradition, energy and vitality.

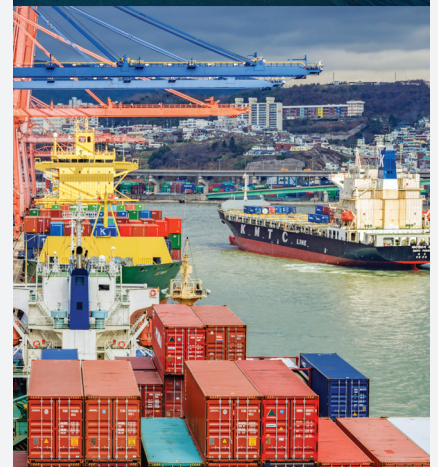
