NOMINATION & APPLICATION STEP BY STEP

• Step I: Nomination

Partner university nominates their students and sends their nomination via NCU form

• Step II: Application

Nominated students have to register via

Online Application System and complete
the application

- Step III: Faculty coordinator accepts your LA
 Faculty coordinator verifies student's Learning
 Agreement and approves it or requests to make some changes
- Step IV: Sending the Invitation Letter
 Once the application is completed and Learning
 Agreement accepted by the Faculty Coordinator,
 an official Invitation Letter will be sent directly to
 the student
