## Deutschlandstipendium

### Duration/amount

Twelve months/€300 per month

### Application

1 September to 30 September

### Requirements

Outstanding achievements; enrolment (within the standard period of study) at the University of Oldenburg in a Bachelor's, Master's or State Examination degree programme.

---

## Lower Saxony state scholarship

### Duration/amount

Around 150 one-off scholarships, €500 each

### Application

1 October to 31 October

### Requirements

Enrolment at the University of Oldenburg in a Bachelor's, Master's or State Examination degree programme as well as 75% of the credit points that can be expected by the end of the summer semester according to the standard period of study.

## The Dr Peter and Doris Waskönig Foundation

### Duration/amount

Six months, around three scholarships, € 650 each per month

### Application

1 March to 31 May

### Requirements

Enrolment at the University of Oldenburg in a Bachelor's, Master's or State Examination degree programme. The scholarship is only granted once.

## The Dr Dettling Foundation

### Duration/amount

One scholarship per semester, €700 per month

### Application

From the beginning of each semester until the end of the lecture period

### Requirements

Enrolment at the University of Oldenburg in a Bachelor's, Master's or State Examination degree programme; residence in Oldenburg; EU citizenship; not entitled to BAföG funding; no more than 10 hours of work per week; graduation is scheduled.

## The Heinz Neumüller Foundation

### Duration/amount

Up to 12 months, around 3 scholarships, €400 per month

### Application

15 October to 31 October

### Requirements

Doctorate at the University of Oldenburg in the fields of technology, computer science, economics, law or natural sciences. No teaching-oriented dissertation topic. No Master of Education degree.

## Academic prize Lower Saxony (Category IV)

### Duration/amount

5 one-off prizes, €3,500 each

### Application

In spring

### Requirements

Enrolment at the University of Oldenburg in a Bachelor's, Master's or State Examination degree programme. Special academic and/or other achievements.
