



# Funding for Ideas around Research-Based Learning in Summer Semester 2024 and Winter Semester 2024/25

The Research-Based Learning Grant Program aims at assisting instructors and students at the University of Oldenburg in implementing research-based learning. Research-based learning refers to the following practice: Students design, perform and reflect on the <u>research process and its fundamental phases</u> (e.g., finding a research question, collecting and analyzing data, presenting results) and do so apart from their final theses. For more information on this approach, please refer to <u>University quidelines on research-based learning</u> (currently available only in German).

This funding opportunity is an extension of previous funding of instructional projects, including, for example, research projects on research-based learning or subject/faculty specific measures on research-based learning.

### Who is eligible for funding?

All instructors and staff members at the University of Oldenburg may apply to this funding opportunity. Student participation is welcome.

## > What is being funded?

Instructors and staff can apply for funds totaling up to €3,000 per semester for hiring student assistants and/or for material resources in Summer Semester 2024 or in Winter Semester 2024/25.

The decision will be made by a committee consisting of representatives from all schools and acting on behalf the Vice President for Instruction and International Affairs.

Notifications of funding will be sent by mid-February 2024.

Applications must include the following:

- The completed application form (PDF).
- Short description of the intended measure with reference to research-based learning as outlined in the University guidelines on research-based learning (max. 4,500 characters with spaces). A maximum of one illustration may be attached as a separate file.
