



Funding for Research-Based Learning Instructional Projects

The Research-Based Learning Grant Program aims to assist instructors at the University of Oldenburg in implementing research-based learning methods in their courses. Research-based learning refers to the following practice: Students design, perform and reflect on the <u>research process and its fundamental phases</u> (e.g., finding a research question, collecting and analyzing data, presenting results) and do so apart from their final theses. Who is eligible for funding?

All instructors at the University of Oldenburg who wish to implement research-based learning methods as part of their courses may apply to this funding opportunity.

What is being funded?

Instructors can apply for funds totaling up to €3,000 per semester for hiring student assistants and/or for material resources.* The decision will be made by a committee consisting of representatives from all schools and acting on behalf the Vice President for Studies an Teaching.

How to apply?

- The submission deadline for funding in the summer semester is 10. January.
- The submission deadline for funding in the winter semester is 10. June.

^{*} Funding for a subsequent course in the following semester is possible (maximum funding €1,500). Please submit a new application at the appropriate time.

Applications must include the following:

- The completed <u>application form (PDF)</u>.
- Short description of approaches and methods for implementing research-based learning and expected number of students (max. 4,500 characters including spaces). A maximum of one illustration may be attached as a separate file. References may be included in a separate document if necessary.
