Grants for materials and supplies for student research projects

Sometimes there is a lack of practical things.... consumables, printed materials or travel to an interview can really make or break a research project.

The University of Oldenburg will provide you with financial support to carry out your research project by covering the cost of materials through the Research-Based Learning Grant Program. You can apply for funding on an ongoing basis.

> Who is eligible for funding?

Students currently enrolled in any degree program at the University of Oldenburg (Bachelor, Master or State Examination Program) who wish to conduct a research project in small groups are eligible to apply. Students are responsible for writing a grant proposal. Their instructor(s) must confirm that the project will be supervised and that the instructor is responsible for obtaining the materials requested or for the financial processing. Final theses such as Bachelor and Master theses are excluded from funding.

What is being funded?

Groups of students can apply for grants (max. €500 per project) to fund research projects that can either be part of regular or extracurricular courses. This includes consumables, for example for setting up experiments or presenting project results, travel to archives or interview partners, printed materials or technical equipment. If you are unsure about the eligibility of your project, please contact us.

> How to apply?

To check your eligibility for funding in principle, please complete the application form "<u>Grants for Materials and Supplies</u> <u>for Student Research Projects</u>" provided on the <u>forschen@studium-website</u> and send it by e-mail to <u>forschen-at-</u> <u>studium@uol.de</u>.

Applications are ongoing, there is no deadline. Applicants will be informed of the funding decision in a timely manner. Please allow four weeks for your application to be processed.
