Climate adaptation

Greenhouse gas balancing third-party funded project

As the <u>Sustainability Network of Universities in Lower Saxony, HochNiNa</u>, we have received approval for a third-party funded project from the Ministry of the Environment in North Rhine-Westphalia. The aim is to develop a standardized framework so that universities do not have to prepare their greenhouse gas balances in different ways, as has been the case up to now - or can be introduced to it at all if they do not yet have a balance sheet. After about 14 months (keyword: lean application procedure), the notification of approval - you read that right - has finally arrived by fax. The half-staff position associated with it can start on 01.08. and we are pleased that it is located for the network with us at the University of Oldenburg.
